

Definition;

Miss Africa Golden (MAG) is a multifaceted event designed to showcase the cultural, social, and economic potential of the African continent on the global stage. It transcends the traditional beauty pageant format, serving as a platform that emphasizes Africa's cultural diversity, female entrepreneurship, and intercontinental collaboration.

The event, hosted by Exposide Global Organization in Istanbul in 2025, seeks to forge enduring commercial, cultural, and academic connections between Africa and Türkiye.

The primary objectives of MAG are:

To establish a cultural and economic connection between African nations and Türkiye.

To establish new collaborative opportunities within the fashion, cosmetics, health, education, and tourism sectors.

To offer global visibility, education, and opportunities for young women in Africa.

To emphasize the themes of sustainability, women's empowerment, and social responsibility.

The 2025 edition, scheduled to take place in Istanbul, will present a comprehensive program featuring fashion shows, cultural events, social responsibility initiatives, and a concluding gala, under the slogan "Istanbul, the Joint Capital of 54 African Countries."

1. SCOPE Socio-Cultural

Miss Africa Golden (MAG) Istanbul 2025 is scheduled to take place from November 9 to November 16.

Each finalist plants a sapling on behalf of themselves or their sponsoring organization. The labeled saplings symbolize environmental awareness and are showcased on digital platforms under the theme "Sustainable Africa."

November 12 - Black Pearl Street Exhibition: Best of Africa (Taksim)

Africa's most stunning cities, natural heritage, esteemed scientists, and cultural achievements are highlighted through photographs and informational displays.

Finalists direct visitors, and content is disseminated on social media and the website under the "Best of Africa" concept.

November 14 – Istanbul Cultural Tour and Evening of Morale (Istanbul)

Finalists explore iconic locations in Istanbul, capturing promotional images centered on the theme of cultural interaction.

November 15 – Concluding Gala Evening (Grand Harilton Hotel)

Finalists grace the stage in their national attire, where they are immersed in a vibrant display of African music and dance. Recordings of the stage performances and fashion show will be shared across the organization's digital platforms.

 This initiative enhances the social impact and digital presence of the event by showcasing African cultural and artistic identity in the heart of Istanbul.





2. SCOPE OF COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES

MAG provides international promotional opportunities for Turkish brands and entrepreneurs aiming at the African market. From November 10th to 15th, special promotional content is created daily for sponsored brands and disseminated across MAG's digital platforms.

November 10 – Inauguration and Digital Marketing Day (Dolmabahçe Palace)

Finalists capture promotional images with their sponsored products at renowned locations throughout the city.

November 15 – Concluding Gala Evening (Grand Harilton Hotel)

Sponsored brands enhance their visibility through fashion shows, LED screens, stages, and catalogs. Post-gala content is disseminated across digital channels.

This coverage offers brands extensive digital reach, Africa-centric visibility, and global exposure daily, without any press obligations.

3. ACADEMIC SCOPE

 Finalists engage with Turkish and international students to discuss the social and economic roles of women in Africa, the future of youth, and educational opportunities.

Academic Collaboration and Erasmus Conferences

Consultations occur between universities and educational institutions regarding Africa-focused exchanges, scholarships, and research initiatives. Participants engage for prospective collaborative projects.

International Student Engagement Program

Meetings and experience-sharing sessions are conducted with African students studying in Turkey.

Topics such as cultural adaptation, educational opportunities, and collaboration prospects are explored.

African International Relations and Educational Initiatives Interview and Consultation Ideas are shared among academics, students, and guests regarding education, research, and social development initiatives undertaken in African nations.

This scope elevates MAG beyond a simple cultural event, transforming it into a platform that fosters Africa-Türkiye academic dialogue, student mobility, and enduring educational collaborations.









EVENTS AND COLLABORATIONS FROM NOVEMBER 10 TO 15

Throughout the program, Turkish companies engaged in Africa-centric product and service sectors will participate in digital promotion and dissemination activities across Africa and in the home countries of the finalists, facilitated by the organization and the finalists themselves.
